Exciting Updates: New Playgrounds and Park Upgrades Coming Soon!

Last month, we shared that Hunt will be building a new destination playground near the Halsey Community Center, along with a painted play pad on Bridges Street. Additionally, a new playground will be installed at the Hokulani Community Center, and the basketball court will be resurfaced.

As part of this process, we will be removing some older parks in disrepair to make way for these new destination parks and play areas.

Starting in March, we will begin demolishing the following:

Halsey Demos:

- The current Community Center playground
- The playground near 770 Sibley
- The playground next to 2863 Anderson
- A new destination park and painted play pad will be coming to the Community Center

Hokulani Demos:

- The existing Community Center playground
- The park at Main and Casey
- The skate ramp and pavilions
- A new playground and resurfaced basketball court will be installed at the Community Center
